

## Web Site Helps Consumers Find Affordable Healthcare Services



If you are uninsured or have high healthcare costs, you may be eligible for free or discounted hospital care. California law requires hospitals to offer reduced rates to patients that have low or moderate income.

Consumers can easily locate which hospitals are in their area searching by facility name, address, city, county and ZIP code. Specific hospital contacts are provided for those with questions on income level eligibility.

While each hospital may evaluate financial criteria differently, in general, patients who have minimal or no health insurance may be eligible for discounted or free healthcare services if:

- Their income is below 350% of the Federal Poverty Level (currently \$80,675 for a family of four), *and*
- They do not have health insurance of any kind, or have health insurance coverage, but their medical costs were more than 10% of their family's income in the last year.
